GARDEN OF HOPE – \$\$\$ Job openings \$\$\$

Needed: Garden Coordinator – Part/Time, approximately 2 hours weekly. That includes ½ hr. meeting with garden interest group and garden staff. Gardening knowledge and teaching skills are required. Stipend of \$100. per month May-September.

Garden workers – 3 part time, averaging 2-3 hours per week to prepare, plant, water and maintain raised garden beds. Salary is minimum wage \$6.55 that is raised to \$7.25 after July 25. One position will include lawn care as well. Must be able to follow directions and learn gardening skills as instructed by the garden coordinator.
